# END OF LIFE/ BEREAVEMENT RESOURCES AVAILABLE FOR ALL PATIENTS:

### • HEART BEAT IN A BOTTLE:

Print out an ECG strip (can photocopy any ECG during admission) & cut down and place in glass bottle. Can tie ribbon around the bottle top

#### • HANDPRINTS:

Use ink-less wipes & keepsake paper. Use 2 pieces of paper & 1 wipe max per patient. 1 wipe can be used multiple times. If more copies are requested by the family, please photocopy.

### HAIR LOCKS

Cut hair & tie around with coloured ribbon. Place in hair-lock bag.

### BEREAVEMENT BOOKS

Multiple books available (both for adults, children & those with added learning needs.) Provide as many books as needed

## • PHOTO-FRAME & CLAY HANDPRINT FRAME

Clay can also be utilised outside of the frame for those with bigger hands. Can also be used in smaller amounts if completing fingerprints instead.

• MEMORY BOXES (complete box)

Contents includes small paper & ink-less wipes, 2 x teddy (one to be placed with patient & other to be given to family), forget me not seeds, notebook.

#### CHILDRENS ACTIVITY/ANXIETY DRAWSTRING BAGS

Useful for any child under 14yrs old (approx). Includes many sensory equipment including anxiety teddy, anxiety & dealing with emotions book, sensory toys. Please provide 1 per child. Can be used for ANY child that is struggling on the unit.
