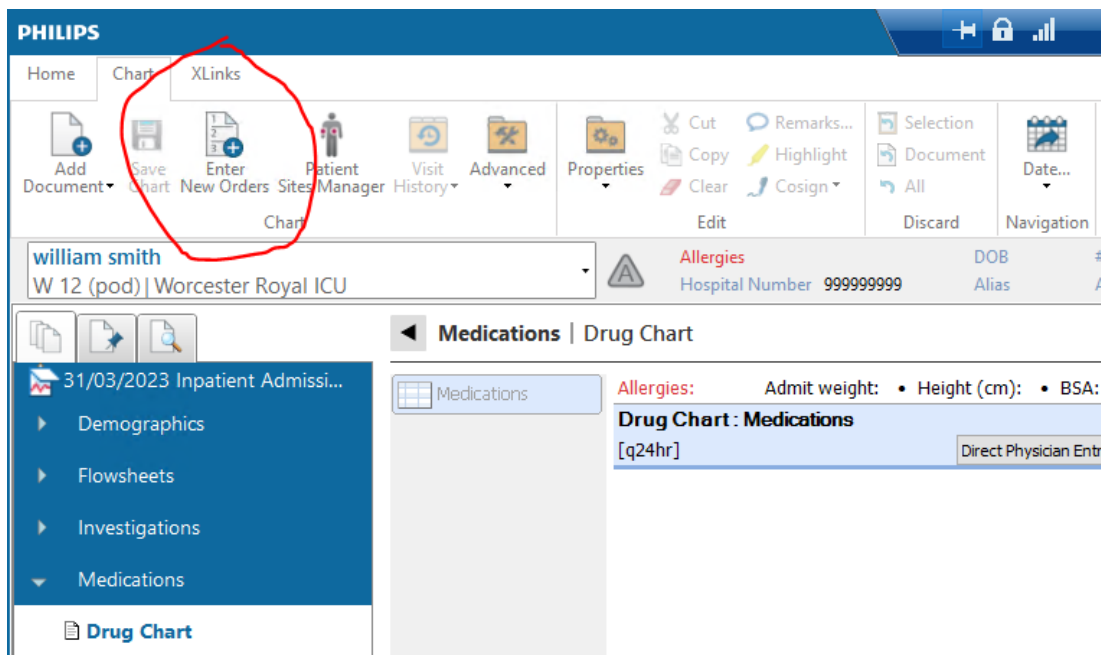


# How to prescribe Enteral Nutrition in ICCA

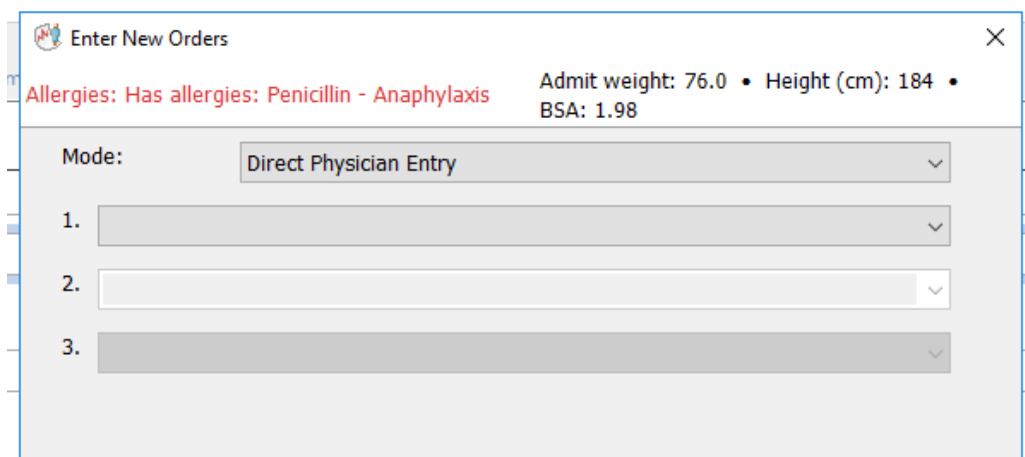
This guide shows how to prescribe enteral feeds and supplements in ICCA. The system separates prescriptions into medications, drug infusions, PCAs, epidurals or nerve catheters, syringe drivers, blood products and TPN. You will need to refer to these other guides if it is one of those items that you wish to prescribe.

Step 1: Access the correct patient's record on ICCA

Step 2: Click on 'Enter New Order'



Step 3: Make a note of the demographic information in the patient banner



Step 4: Select 'Blood & Enteral Feeds' from the first drop down list

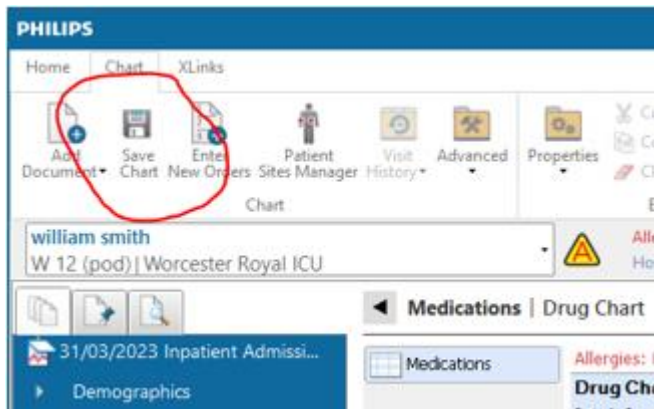

Appendix 1: what to do if you need to prescribe a non-standard enteral feed or supplement

Firstly, please email the Lead Pharmacist for Critical Care and EPMA and let the ICCA team know what needs to be added.

To add a non-standard enteral product, do not select anything from the drop down menu, or click on the down arrow at the right hand side to clear the selection so it is blank.

*NB: non-standard nutritional products do not have any nutrient values attached to them, and therefore the Nutrient Calculator app cannot be used.*

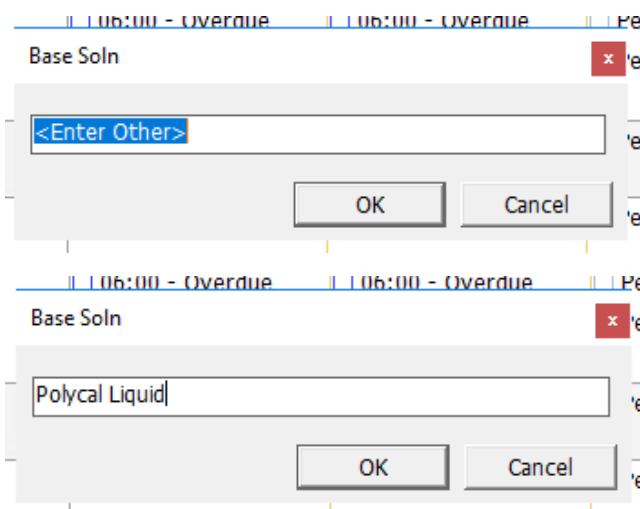

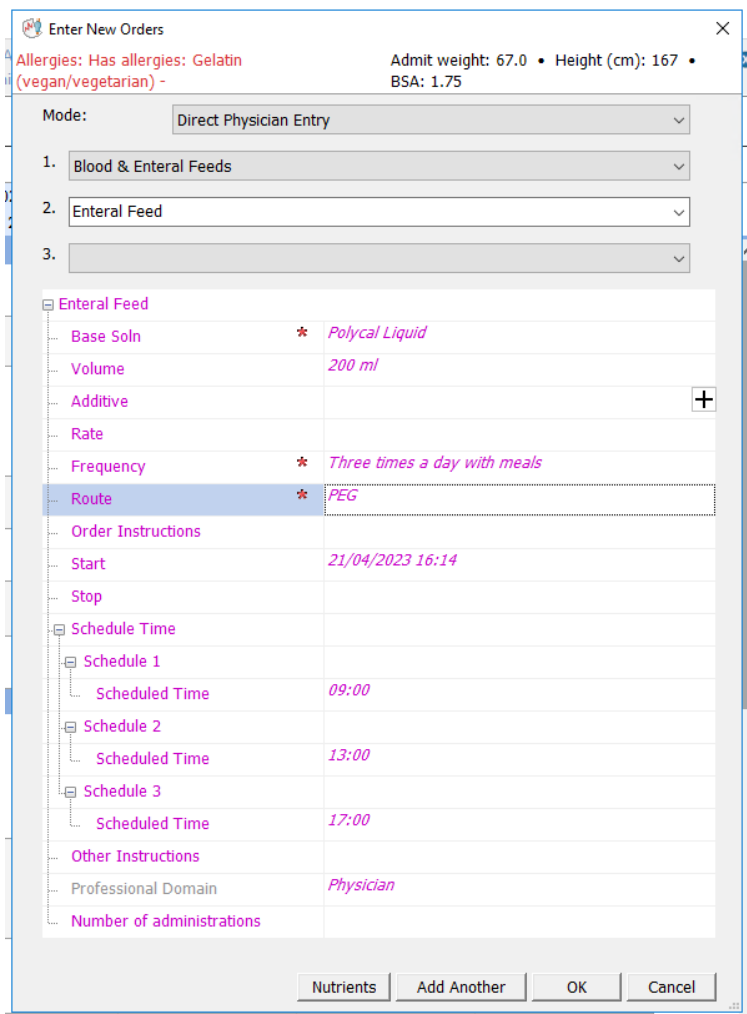
